

## TYPE OF EVIDENCE PROJECT

1. You **MUST** have your type of evidence approved by Miss Keen.
2. You **MAY** work by yourself or with **ONE** other person.
3. The project is due on Dec 14 (Mon) or Dec 15 (Tues)
4. The point value of this project is 60 points. (A test grade)

### **RUBRIC for this project: (POSTER or PAPER)**

- A. 5 points **COVER PAGE** (must have a photo of your evidence)  
-Your name(s), Period, name of evidence, photo, in color (if available)
- B. 10 points- Background on your evidence  
-the basics about your evidence, what is it?
- C. 10 points- How would a forensic scientist collect this evidence?
- D. 10 points- How often is this type of evidence used? What kind of case is this evidence used in or collected for? Give one specific example of a case the evidence was used in.
- E. 5 points-Authenticity and aesthetic value (make it pretty)

\*if you choose to do a POSTER all of the information should neatly be displayed on the front of the poster. Your name should be on the back. The size of the poster should be small (12'x18') to medium (24'x36'). No larger poster boards please.

### Examples of Types of Evidence to choose from:

- Blood, Skin, Saliva, Hair, Fiber, Bullets, Weapons, Fingerprints
- Footprints, Cosmetics, Glass, Paint chips, Explosives
- Plant material, Bone fragments, Drug paraphernalia
- Documents, Ransom Note, Firearms, Bullets
- Impressions, tire tracks, fabric design, bite marks
- Toxicology, poisons, petroleum products, plastic bags
- VIN, soil profile, mineral profile, tool marks
- Vehicle lights, wood, pollen
